Architectural Award for **Rahul Deshpande**



Mangueshi Devasthan was recently awarded the A+D 'Best Institutional Architecture Award 2010'. Architect Rahul Deshpande was the architect who worked on the temple's re-vitalisation. He has won numerous national and international awards and is also a special invitee on TCP and GSIDC board. The A+D awards are held annually and the best talents of the year in India and south east Asia are selected in various categories. The

Mangueshi temple, a 300 year old complex houses temple of Lord Manguesh and *agarshalas* along with the temple of Mulkeshwar and *Purush* needed immediate attention and the Devasthan committee in 2008 undertook the task of upgrading its infrastructure. The design included the construction of the new *Agarshala* building, reconstruction of Mulkeshwar temple and development of *Prakaar*.

Rahul Deshpande mentioned that designing the complex completed in Jan 2010 was indeed a challenge as new structures had to blend with the character and architectural language of the place, yet had to be contemporary and provide state of the art amenities ■

Nirmal Kulkarni wins Carl Zeiss Wildlife Award

Goa based herpetologist and field ecologist, Nirmal U. Kulkarni was acknowledged at the 11th Carl Zeiss Wildlife Conservation awards ceremony for his research and conservation initiatives in the Mhadei Bio region. He was part of a team that discovered two new species of legless amphibians, the caecilians - Goan caecilian (*Gegeneophis goensis*) and Mhadei caecilian (*Gegeneophis mhadeiensis*) besides having mapped and extensively documented the lesser-known biodiversity of the region.



The award recognised his expertise in combining science photography and activism in the Northern Western Ghats of India where he works. As a trainer, he has helped shape young nature enthusiasts into foot soldiers for India's wildlife research and conservation movement - particularly reptile conservation ■
